Who can help me get my knowledge and skills assessed?

How would it happen?

An interview of 1-2 hours in a place where you are comfortable, and some follow-up. The initial interview will identify possible qualifications. Then an education and training organisation will carry out some assessment. It will issue you with the qualifications where you have demonstrated competence.



Would a qualification be helpful to me?

Yes:

- it would make me feel proud of what I have learnt
- it could help me get a job or a better job
- I might use a qualification as a starting point for more study.

Do I have the knowledge and skills to get a qualification?

Yes, probably.

I have learnt a lot through:

- jobs
- family life
- working in the community
- sports and hobbies
- voluntary work.

What will it cost me?

The initial interview will not cost you anything. You may have to contribute to the cost of assessment.
