

CHANGES TO VET QUALIFICATION CONTRIBUTION TO THE TCE STANDARDS

At its meeting on 2 August 2011 the Authority decided to amend the way in which a number of Vocational Education and Training (VET) qualifications were considered evidence that a learner had met one or more of the TCE's 'everyday adult' skill set standards. These decisions are outlined in the table below. They will impact on learners who commence a course in a listed qualification after 31 December 2011. The size value and complexity of the qualifications are not affected by these decisions.
